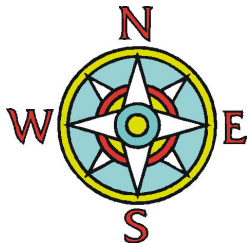


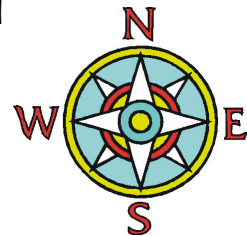

Wednesday, April 27th

A Little Bit of Cleveland \$38

The morning begins at the historic West Side Market, home to over 100 vendors of great ethnic diversity—feel free to bring a cooler if you plan to make perishable purchases! Next stop—the renowned Cleveland Museum of Art. Explore the exhibits and enjoy lunch on your own at the Museum Café. Then on to the Great Lakes Science Center to view “Born to be Wild” at the fantastic OmniMax theater. Post Tours

Monday, May 23rd

Holmes County Amish Tour \$55

Spring is beautiful in Ohio—and a wonderful time to explore the Brandywine Valley, home to several Amish and Mennonite communities. Stops include: Heini’s Cheese, The Carlisle House, Family Style meal at Der Dutchman, Sugarcreek (the “Little Switzerland of Ohio”), Dutch Valley Meats & Breitenbach Winery. Great Day Tours

Wednesday, June 22nd

Cleveland Zoo \$41 adults/ \$39 kids

A family-friendly trip to the zoo for all ages! Kids and Grandkids are invited on this visit to Northeast Ohio’s premier zoo. Lots of wonderful exhibits, including African Savannah, Australian Adventure, Waterfowl Lake, and of course—the Rainforest! Pack a picnic lunch or enjoy the many food options available at the park. Free Zootrams run throughout the park, and all areas are wheelchair accessible (rentals available—advance reservation required). Post Tours

Wednesday, July 20th

Goodtime III Cruise \$64

Goodtime III is the largest quadruple-deck luxury ship on the Great Lakes. Board the vessel and enjoy brunch dockside before taking to the water for a narrated cruise on Lake Erie and the Cuyahoga River. On the way home, stop at Tremont Scoops Old-Fashioned Ice Cream Parlor for treats and coffee on your own. Post Tours

Monday, September 12th

Marblehead/Vermilion \$50

Begin the day at Marblehead Lighthouse. A park ranger will share information about the many significant features of this historic area. Bring a picnic lunch—the grounds surrounding the lighthouse offer excellent picnicking and views of Lake Erie, Sandusky Bay, Kelley's Island and South Bass Island. Then visit The Richmond Gallery to see Ben Richmond's Lighthouse Paintings. Then on to Vermilion for a tour of the Inland Maritime Seas Museum and a look around town. Post Tours

Wednesday, October 26th

Raven's Glenn Winery/Canal Boat Ride \$75

This tour centers around Raven's Glenn, Ohio's fourth-largest winery located on the banks of the beautiful Tuscarawas River. Enjoy a buffet lunch, tour of the winery, and wine tasting—and take home a complimentary etched wine glass. Next stop: the Holmes County flea market to explore the wares. Then travel along the Ohio and Erie canal aboard the Monticello III—a horse-drawn canal boat. Great Day Tours

Cleveland Food Show \$50

Travel to the IX Center for this year's Fabulous Food Show—an annual celebration of culinary delights! Enjoy "The Marketplace" —lots of demonstrations and products to see and taste. In the "Main Kitchen", a celebrity chef will cook and entertain—admission is included. The "Taste of the Neighborhood" stage hosts local chefs. "Sweet Street" hosts baking and chocolate experts. The "Fabulous Bistro" sells food for those looking for a meal in addition to all of the sampling! "Cleveland by Hand" features Cleveland Artists showing their wares. Post Tours

Tuba Christmas \$39

A holiday favorite—the 32nd annual Tuba Christmas at Akron's EJ Thomas Hall is a wonderful way to celebrate the season! Hundreds of tubas make this a memorable musical event. No reserved seating—so wear comfy shoes in case we have to stand in line. Then travel to Donzell's to enjoy the Christmas trees and flowers before heading to dinner at The Cathedral Buffet. 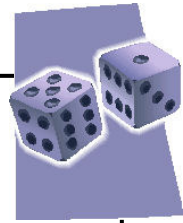

SEATING POLICY for ALL BUS TRIPS

We will be repeating last year's successful seating plan as follows:

- **Seat assignments will be on a first come basis with full payment.**
- **You will be given a ticket with your seat assignment clearly listed; please honor it.**
- **2 of the front seats will be reserved for Handicapped seating.** Once those seats are filled it will again revert to first come, first seated in order so if you wish or need to use the handicapped seating, please sign up early.
- **Definition of Handicapped:** Anyone who requires assistance to walk or has trouble navigating the bus aisle (so anyone in a wheelchair, on a walker or cane qualifies.)

OTHER POLICIES

NEW Please park in the lot behind Grace Lutheran Church, next door to the Center.
The bus will park on King Street (between Center and Church) for boarding passengers.

Cancellation refunds will be at the discretion of the tour companies. All checks will be deposited with the travel lines as they are collected. Checks will not be held at the Center.

Payment by **Checks or Money Orders** only. Please make out checks to the individual tour companies: Post Tours, Great Day Tours, or TBI Tours.

Please be prompt for your trips. Be here by the time listed on your tickets.
