

BID NOTICE

Sealed bids will be received by the Director of Public Service of the City of Wadsworth at City Hall, 120 Maple Street, Wadsworth, Oh 44281 until one o'clock (1:00 p.m.), EST on Friday, October 9, 2009 at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the furnishing of all necessary labor, materials and equipment to perform Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement, according to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service of said city, which are open for inspection by any bidder.

The work covered by the plans and specifications includes furnishing all labor and material for the sanitary sewer rehabilitation and replacement along Orchard Trunk Sewer and Memorial Park Trunk Sewer and all other appertaining work necessary to complete the project. The improvement work must be completed within 90 days of Contact commencement. All bidders must be qualified by experience and properly equipped to complete the work specified in the time allotted. The engineer's estimate for this construction is \$350,000 (base bid).

All proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement" and addressed to and delivered to the Director of Public Service, City of Wadsworth, Ohio. Each bid must be submitted on the form provided by the City and must be fully completed and submitted intact. Each bid shall contain the entire bid book with all addendums. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting bid.

Plans and specifications can be seen at the City Engineering Office at 120 Maple Street, Wadsworth, Ohio or at the Burgess and Niple Akron Office at 50 South Main St, Suite 600. Copies may be obtained at the Burgess and Niple address upon payment of \$100.00 on or after September 22, 2009 (NONE OF WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED). **Purchase of a bid packet from Burgess and Niple is required to be considered for this project.**

Each bidder shall be required to file with its bid, the following:

1. A bid guarantee in the form of either:
 - a. A bond as set forth in the bid documents for the full amount of the bid, or
 - b. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code. A letter of credit shall be revocable only at the option of the City. The amount of the certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit shall equal 10% of the grand total of the bid.
2. A Non-Collusion Affidavit
3. Statement of Bidder Resources and Experience
4. Declaration of Material Assistance/Non-Assistance to a Terrorist Organization
5. DBE Utilization

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on public improvements in Medina County, Ohio as determined by all Davis Bacon requirements and or the Ohio Department of commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety, Wage and Hour Bureau requirements.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive irregularities therein.
