BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council hereby determines that it is necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings or sites therefor or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of fire-alarm communications or for the payment of other related services and requests the County Auditor of Medina County, Ohio to certify to this council the total tax valuation of the City of Wadsworth and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by an additional continuing levy of 1.1 mills for each one dollar of valuation, to first be levied in 2020 and first collected in 2021 to appear on the ballot at the November 3, 2020 election. Submission of the question of the tax is authorized by section 5705.19(I) of the Ohio Revised Code. The territory where the tax is to be levied shall be the entire territory of the City of Wadsworth, Medina County, Ohio and the City has territory in Medina County and in no other county.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council shall on behalf of this Council forthwith certify a copy of this resolution to the Auditor of Medina County, Ohio.
