**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 2020 FORD SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES THROUGH AN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT OR UPON EQUIVALENT TERMS CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS BUT AT A LOWER PRICE THAN THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN AN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**Whereas**, section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a political subdivision to participate in purchase contracts of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services and this Council by its Ordinance 11-110 has provided for the City of Wadsworth to participate in said state contracts; and

**Whereas**, section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code also permits a political subdivision to make a purchase from another party upon equivalent terms conditions and specifications but at a lower price than it can through a contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services; and

**Whereas**, pursuant to sections 737.03 and 735.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorization of this Council is only required for the Director of Public Safety to make an expenditure exceeding fifty thousand dollars but nonetheless this Council wishes to specifically articulate its approval of the purchase of two (2) 2020 Ford Sport Utility Vehicles involving a lesser expenditure; NOW THEREFORE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to purchase two (2) 2020 Ford Sport Utility Vehicles through an Ohio Department of Administrative Services contract or upon equivalent terms conditions and specifications but at a lower price than through participation in an Ohio Department of Administrative Services contract. The purchase shall be made from the Ganley Ford Barberton/Norton dealership of Barberton, Ohio for a purchase price of \$65,000.00.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to provide needed police cars for the department of public safety; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds vote of all members of City Council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
