**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR AND RECEIVE BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR TREE TRIMMING AND TREE REMOVAL FOR ELECTRIC LINES CLEARANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for and receive bids and to enter into a contract for tree trimming and tree removal for electric lines clearance as to distribution lines within the area designated by the Director of Public Service as Section 1 (Distribution) and as to transmission lines within the area designated by the Director of Public Service as Section T1.

**Section 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to expedite the removal of trees or portions of trees that need to be removed for the safe, reliable and efficient operation of the City of Wadsworth Electric Utility; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AGREEMENT WITH NDG REAL ESTATE LLC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, NDG Real Estate LLC proposes an investment by making capital improvements to real property in the City of Wadsworth; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has reviewed the application for tax exemption and considered the total investment by NDG Real Estate LLC and job creation for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has recommended a percent and term of tax exemption that is in conformance with Ordinance 52-92 regarding tax exemption policy and other guidelines adopted by the Council for the Quadral/Seville (CRA) Community Reinvestment Area Zone; NOW THEREFORE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That based on the amount of investment and payroll proposed for the project and other considerations, the agreement for tax exemption between the City of Wadsworth and NDG Real Estate LLC shall permit a real property tax exemption of 40% for a term of 12 years.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor of the City of Wadsworth is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for tax exemption between the City of Wadsworth and NDG Real Estate LLC with term and percent of exemption as defined by section one of this ordinance.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to allow execution of a tax exemption agreement prior to the start of construction thus promoting economic development, WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That this Council, pursuant to section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby finds the existence of a real and present emergency in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Service necessitating authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Advanced Control Systems, Inc. for the purchase of six NTX-200 upgrades for the existing NTU-7550 RTUs without formal bidding and advertising.

**Section 2.** That based upon the aforesaid real and present emergency, this Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Advanced Control Systems, Inc. for the purchase of six NTX-200 upgrades for the existing NTU-7550 RTUs without formal bidding and advertising. The payment obligation pursuant to said contract shall not exceed sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000).

**Section 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to expedite the purchase of needed equipment for city owned substation(s); WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VARIOUS ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 20-06 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, this Council has previously adopted Resolution 20-06 pursuant to section 721.15(D) of the Ohio Revised Code regarding the sale of city owned personal property by internet auction which provided that items of personal property may be sold pursuant to that resolution when said items are authorized to be sold by subsequent resolution of this Council, and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has determined that various items of personal property owned by the City of Wadsworth are not needed for public use or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired and should be sold by internet auction pursuant to Resolution 20-06;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That pursuant to Section 2 of Resolution 20-06, this Council hereby authorizes the sale of the various items of personal property listed on Exhibit A attached to this ordinance by internet auction in the manner provided for in Resolution 20-06 and authorizes a contract with Public Surplus to conduct said internet auction.

**Section 2.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to avoid the burden of keeping property no longer needed for municipal purposes and to obtain additional funds for use in providing public services; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council.
