ORDINANCE NO. 21-034

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT CONSOLIDATING WADSWORTH CITY LOTS 6462 AND 10150, CREATING NEW WADSWORTH CITY LOT 10164 AS APPROVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION ON MAY 10, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby accepts public right of way as shown on the plat consolidating Wadsworth City Lots 6462 and 10150, creating new Wadsworth City Lot 10164 as approved by the Planning Commission on May 10, 2021.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to promote economic development; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
