AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR AND RECEIVE BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FORTY FIVE FOOT ARTICULATING TELESCOPIC AERIAL DEVICE INCLUDING BODY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for and receive bids and to enter into a contract for the purchase of a forty five foot articulating telescopic aerial device including body in accordance with specifications prescribed by the Director of Public Service, at a total cost not to exceed \$140,000.

Section 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to expedite the acquisition of an aerial device needed by the Department of Public Service; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO DONATE CERTAIN OLD FIRE EQUIPMENT FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO THE FOUR CITIES COMPACT FOR ITS FIRE SAFETY/EMT PROGRAM AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby determines that certain old Fire Equipment consisting of the items listed on Exhibits A attached hereto are no longer needed by the Fire Department and that it is in the public interest to donate the items listed on Exhibit A to the Four City Compact for its Fire Safety/EMT Program.

Section 2. That this Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Safety to donate the items listed on Exhibit A to the Four City Compact for its Fire Safety/EMT Program.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to avoid having to continue to store obsolete and no longer needed fire department equipment; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval of a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 20-19

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF WADSWORTH IN ORDER TO RECEIVE ITS SHARE OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the “Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act” in H.B. 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, H.B. 481 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, City of Wadsworth is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Services is hereby authorized to take any and all necessary actions required by the City of Wadsworth in order to receive its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

Section 2. The Director of Public Service will affirm that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to H.B. 481 be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in City of Wadsworth’s most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

Section 3. That the Director of Public Service and the Auditor of the City of Wadsworth will also take all the following actions to be in compliance with H.B. 481:

- (1) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the City of Wadsworth's local coronavirus relief fund to the County Treasurer;
- (2) On or before December 28, 2020, pay the balance of any money in the City of Wadsworth's local coronavirus relief fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and
- (3) Provide any information related to any payments received under H.B. 481 to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.

Section 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to apply for funds necessary for public services as soon as possible during the COVID-19 pandemic; WHEREFORE, this resolution shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
