

## Proof of Insurance

If your ticket indicates you failed to show proof of financial responsibility for the vehicle involved at the time of the traffic stop (proof of insurance) you will need to show proof of insurance to the Court. If you fail to do this, the BMV will suspend your license as it is *illegal to drive without insurance in the state of Ohio*. For your convenience, the Court will accept proof of financial responsibility by email, fax, regular mail, or in person.

**\*\*To be valid, the proof of insurance must show the vehicle involved was covered on the date of the violation. Expired insurance policies, policies which do not cover the vehicle involved in the traffic stop, and policies which do not show coverage for the date of the violation will not be accepted.**

## Driving Privileges for suspended licenses

If you are under a license suspension for a Physical Control or a drug or alcohol related OVI, you will need to provide at minimum the following information to apply for occupational driving privileges:

- Valid proof of insurance showing you as a driver are covered under a current insurance policy.
- Employment information which must include the name of your employer, employer's address, work schedule/hours you work, supervisor's name and telephone number. *\*\*Please note, if you drive in the course of your employment, there will be additional information required. Please contact the Clerk's office for more information.*
- \$10.00 Filing fee

Reasonable requests for occupational driving privileges will be granted after any hard suspension time has expired, as long as the defendant's license would be otherwise considered valid, and as long as any requirements for occupational driving privileges ordered at sentencing have been met.
