

RESIDENTIAL HVAC PERMITS ARE REQUIRED to install furnaces & air conditioning in any one, two or three-family residential dwelling, garage, or other structure within the limits of the city except for the following:

RESIDENTIAL HVAC PERMITS ARE NOT REQUIRED for:

1. *Portable heating, cooking, or clothes drying appliances;*
2. *Replacement of any minor part that does not alter approval of equipment or make such equipment unsafe.*
3. *Portable fuel cell appliances that are not connected to a fixed piping system and are not interconnected to a power grid.*
4. *Gas distribution piping owned and maintained by public or municipal utilities and located upstream of the point of delivery.*
5. *Portable ventilation equipment;*
6. *Portable cooling units*
7. *Steam, hot or chilled water piping within any heating or cooling equipment regulated by this code.*
8. *Portable evaporative cooler.*
9. *Self-contained refrigeration systems containing ten pounds (4.54 kg) or less of refrigerant or that are actuated by motors of one horsepower(746 W) or less.*
10. *Process equipment including the associated tanks, foundations, and process piping. For combination building services/process or power piping systems, the power or process piping located downstream of the control valve which separates the process from the building services piping is exempt from approval.*

RESIDENTIAL HVAC REGISTRATION

RESIDENTIAL HVAC CONTRACTORS must possess a valid city registration in order to perform work on one, two, or three-family dwellings in the city.

COMMERCIAL HVAC CONTRACTORS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED as no commercial permits are issued by the City, they are issued by the Medina Co. Bldg. Dept.

HOMEOWNERS EXEMPTION. The owner of a single-family dwelling who intends to personally perform electrical work on a dwelling used, or to be used, as the owner's personal residence, may be issued a permit providing that said owner signs an affidavit stating that he is the owner and occupant of the dwelling, will reside at the location for at least one year, and will personally perform the work upon the premises for which a permit is required.

REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Requirements:

1. Qualification certification, issued by the Ohio Construction Industry Examining Board.
2. Proof of compliance with the worker's compensation laws of the state.
3. Application for a registration shall be made to the Building Department accompanied by a payment of fee of \$50.

Renewal. Each registration will be issued by calendar year, and may be renewed prior to January 1 of the next year upon payment of a renewal fee of \$20.

1. Renewal applications shall be accompanied a current state qualification certificate and proof of workers compensation.
2. No electrical permits will be issued until such registration has been obtained or renewed.

Submission & Payment

- *Complete the Permit Application* (and registration application if necessary) and submit this time by email or mail with an email address included.
- Payments (checks) may accompany the applications if mailed, or be made after permit approval with a credit card by phone

- Receipts and permits will then be returned by email if possible or mailed.

REGISTRATION RULES

All work done beyond the weather head on overhead electrical services, and the point of electrical service on underground services, with the exception of meters, are subject to registration rules and permit fees.

1. Exception: An empty underground raceway may be installed by an unlicensed contractor for one, two, and three family residential dwellings and accessory building projects provided all work is performed by either a registered contractor or the resident property owner of a single-family structure or a city.
2. A registered contractor may subcontract work to any subcontractor holding a valid registration. Such subcontractor shall be required to transfer this permit into his name.
3. A registered contractor may hire employees to work directly for the contractor and to actually perform the work involved. The registered contractor shall, however, be responsible for all work performed under his registration by his employees.
4. No registered contractor or subcontractor shall allow his name to be used by any person, directly or indirectly, either to obtain a permit or to do work under his certificate or registration
