

ORDINANCE NO. 26-001

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL CABLE TELEVISION COOPERATIVE, INC. (NCTC) FOR VIDEO SERVICES REQUIRED TO SUPPORT CITYLINK OPERATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with National Cable Television Cooperative, Inc. (NCTC) for video services required to support CityLink operations and its service delivery offerings. The total price to be awarded pursuant to said contract shall not exceed \$2,675,000.

Section 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to provide for more fair and appropriate rates for continued video services; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
