AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PURCHASE A NEW CATERPILLAR MODEL 926 14A WHEEL LOADER FROM OHIO CAT THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN A SOURCEWELL CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a political subdivision to participate in a joint purchasing program operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivisions in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership and the equipment is available under Sourcewell Contract and section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a political subdivision to participate in purchase contracts of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has determined that a new Caterpillar Model 926 14a Wheel Loader, including all standard equipment and options, is available for purchase from Ohio CAT through participation in a Sourcewell contract and that it is in the best interest of the City of Wadsworth to purchase said needed new Caterpillar Model 926 14a Wheel Loader, including all standard equipment and options, through participation in the said Sourcewell contract, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 735.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorization of this Council is required for the Director of Public Service to make an expenditure exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars; **NOW THEREFORE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to purchase a new Caterpillar Model 926 14a Wheel Loader, including all standard equipment and options, at a cost of \$215,255.00 for said equipment from Ohio CAT through participation in a Sourcewell contract pursuant to section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to provide needed equipment for the department of public service; **WHEREFORE**, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds vote of all members of City Council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
